

## **JCI Oath of Membership**

The decision to become a member of JCI is one that should be taken seriously. Taking an oath of membership means that you are committed to the mission, vision and values of this organization. You shall be guided by this oath throughout your involvement. This is a very solemn and memorable moment in your experience as a JCI member.

The Local President, a visiting National Officer or International Officer usually administers the oath. He or she begins by asking the new members to raise their right hand and repeat:

“I do solemnly swear that I will faithfully serve as a member of (name of the Local Organization) and will, to the best of my ability, serve as a living example of this organization’s philosophy and beliefs and will uphold and enforce the Constitution of the Local Organization, the National Organization and JCI at all times.”

A pin is offered to the new member along with the welcome letter, constitution of the Local Organization and the JCI Mission, Vision and Values (creed).
